In exercise of the powers conferred by section 25 of the Health Insurance Act (2021 Revision), the Cabinet makes the following Regulations —

Citation and commencement

1. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Health Insurance (Amendment) Regulations, 2026.
- (2) These Regulations come into force immediately after the *Health Insurance (Amendment) Act, 2026* comes into force.

Amendment of regulation 5 of Health Insurance Regulations (2017 Revision) - health care for indigent persons

2. The *Health Insurance Regulations (2017 Revision)* are amended in regulation 5 as follows —
 - (a) by repealing the regulation heading and substituting the following regulation heading —
“**Health care for medically indigent persons**”; and

- (b) in paragraph (1), by deleting the words “indigent persons” and substituting the words “medically indigent persons”.
